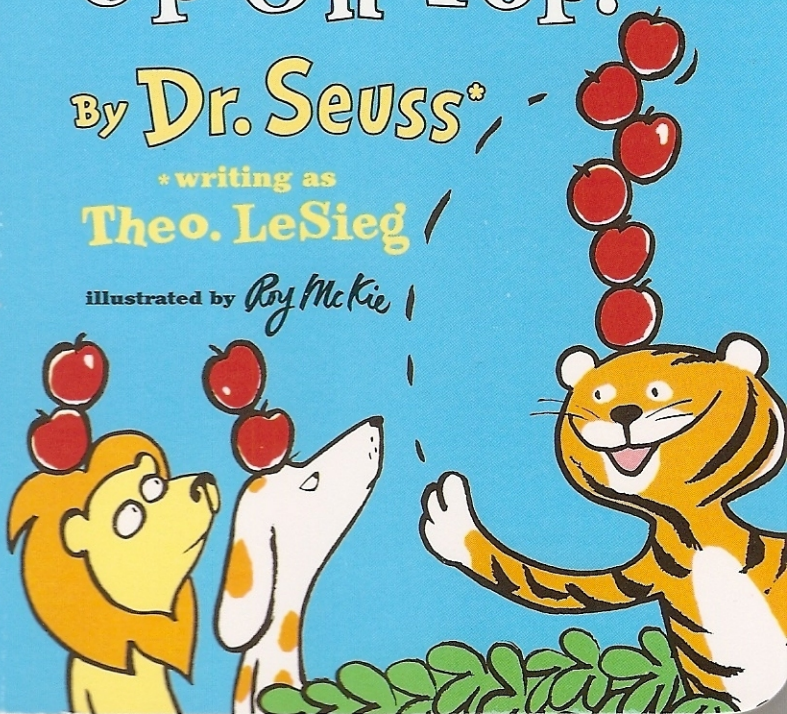
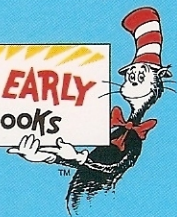

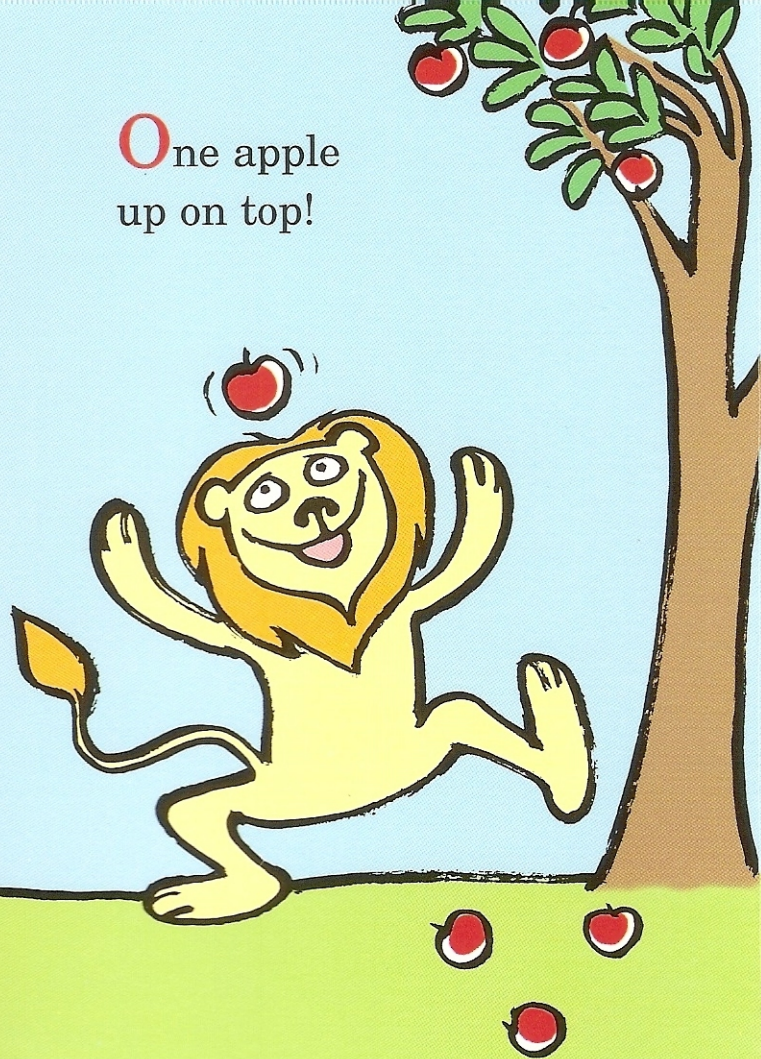


**Dr. Seuss's real name was Theodor Geisel.

which is Geisel spelled backward.*

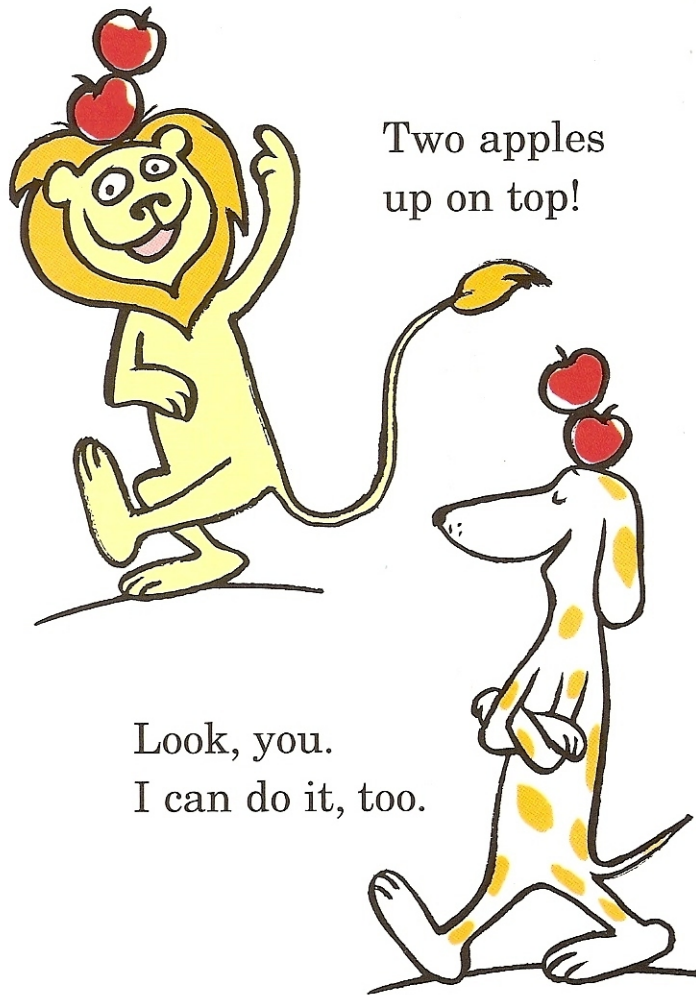

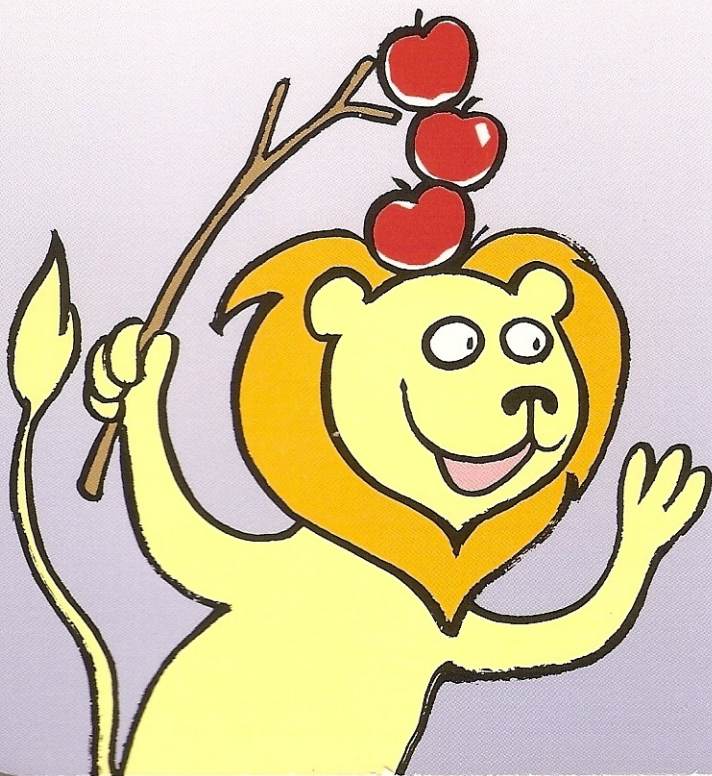


Two apples
up on top!



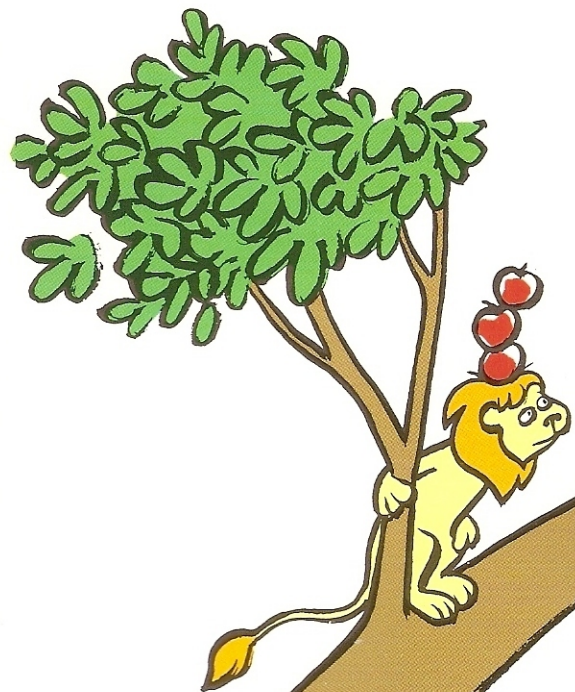
Look, you.

I can do three!



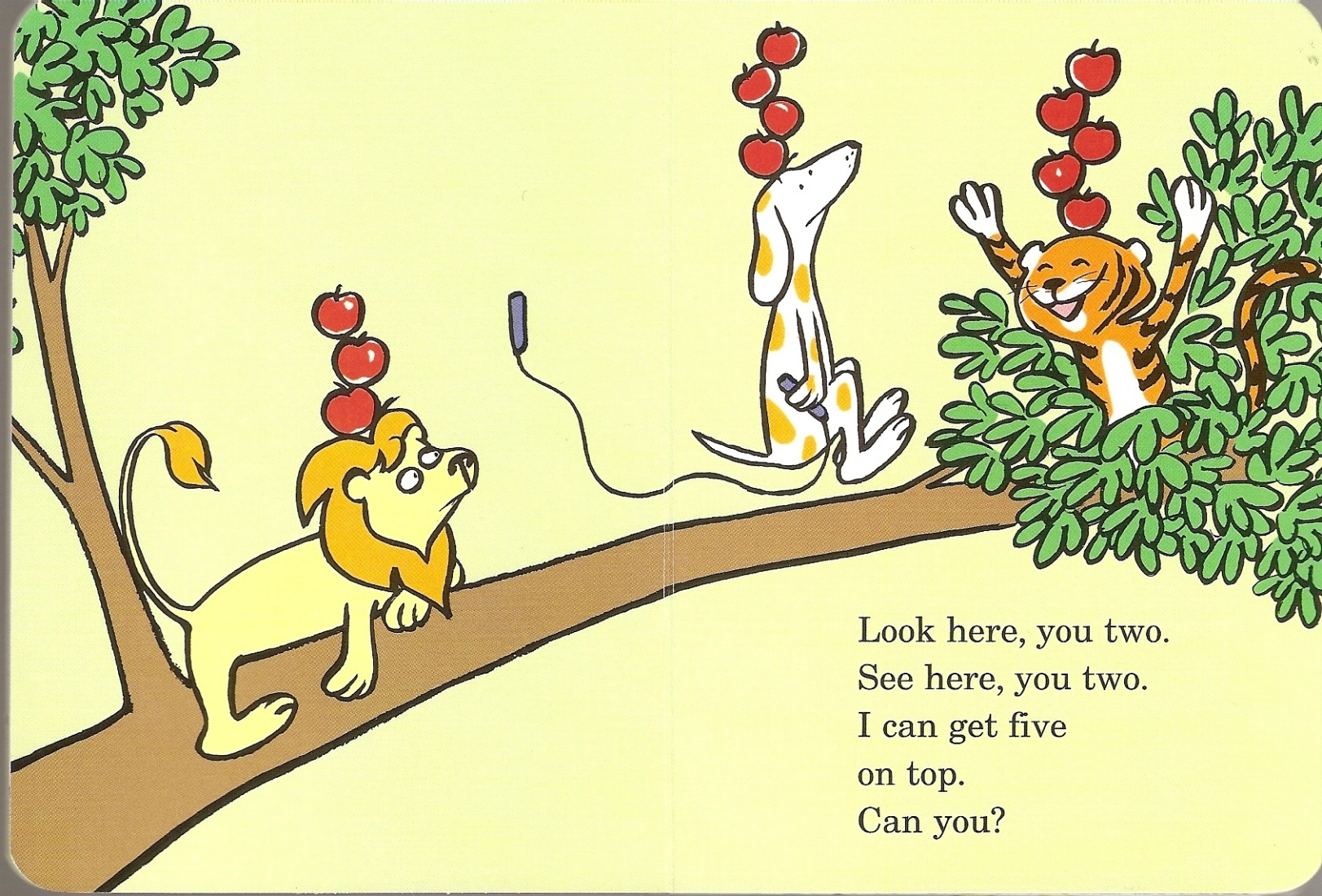
You can do three,

but I have four.



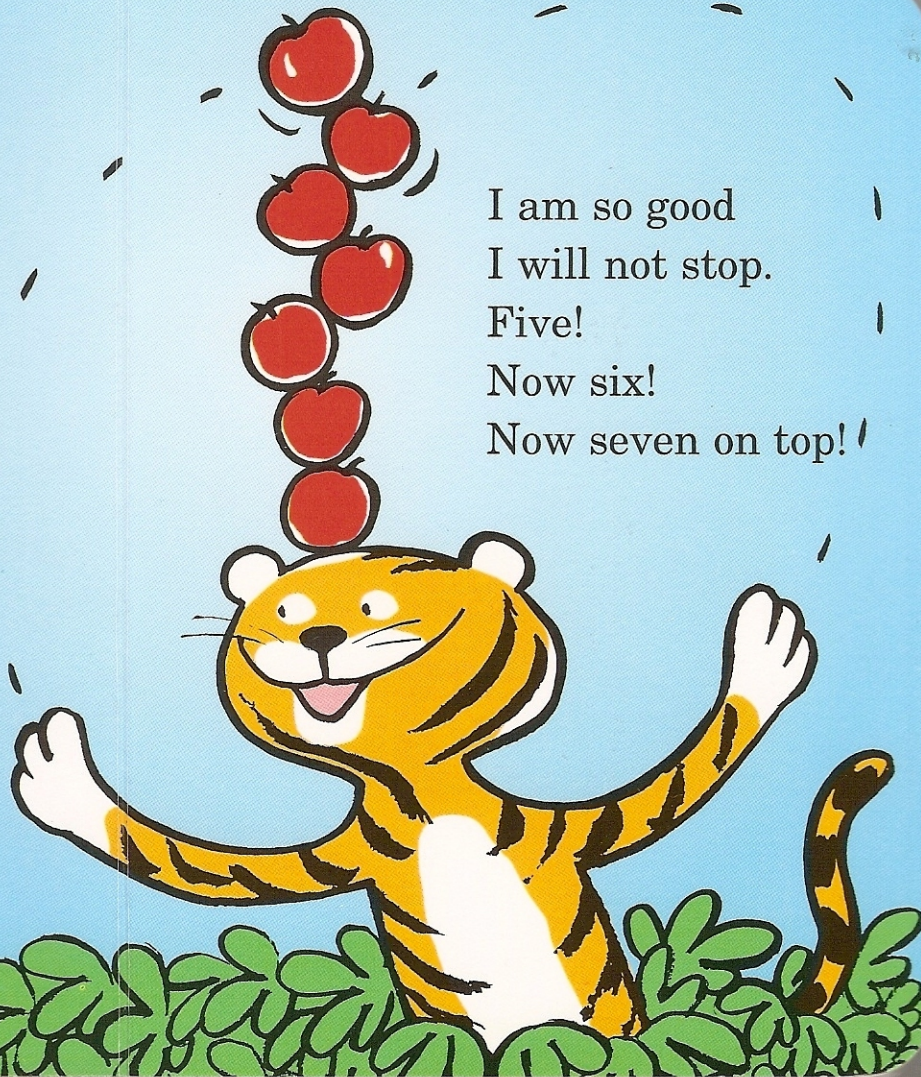


Look! See, now.

up on me.



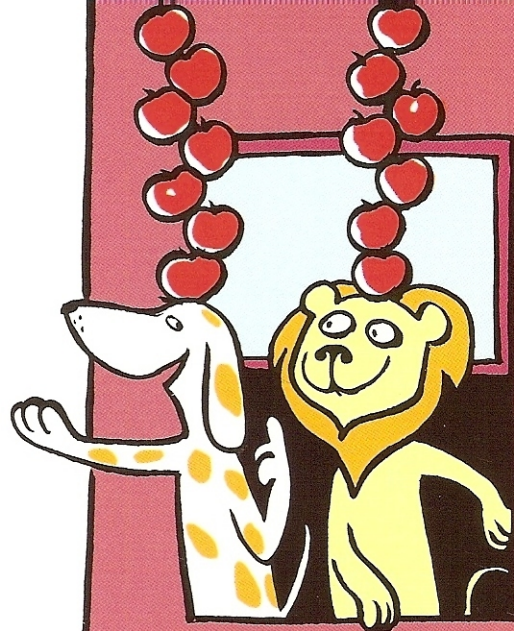
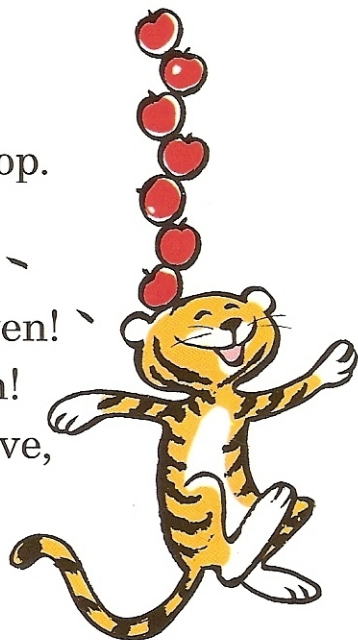
Look here, you two.

Can you?



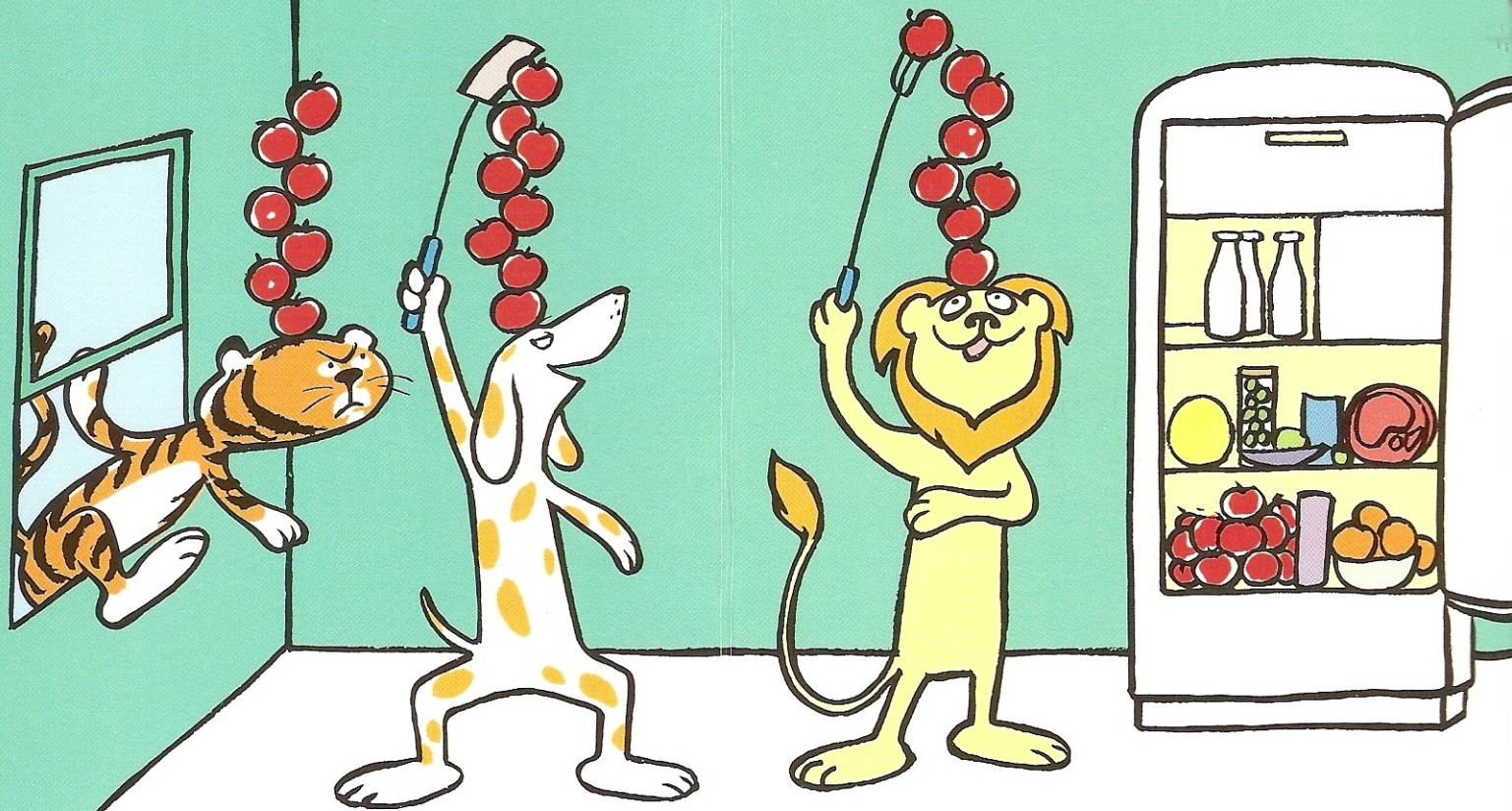
I am so good

one!

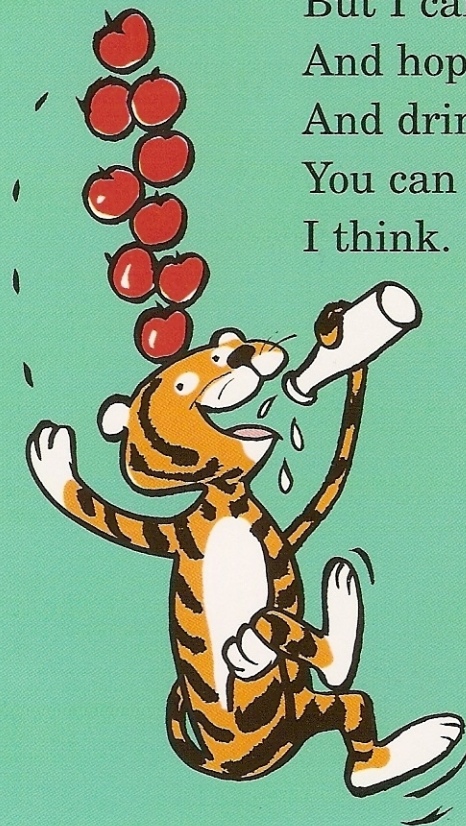
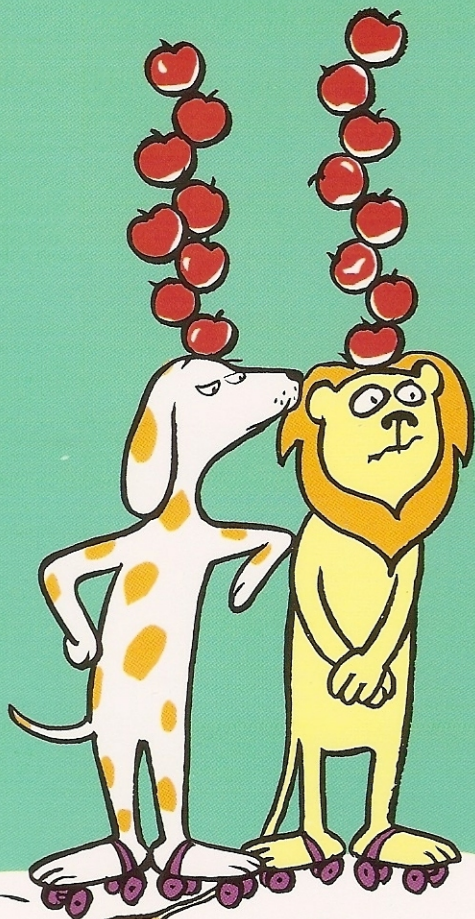


But, see!
