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Tips for Reading Together

Children learn best when reading is fun.

- Talk about the title and the picture on the cover.
- Discuss what you think the story might be about.
- Read the story together, inviting your child to read with you.
- Give lots of praise as your child reads with you, and help them when necessary.
- If they get stuck, try reading the first sound or syllable of the word, or read the whole sentence. Focus on the meaning.
- Re-read the story later, encouraging your child to read as much of it as they can.

Children enjoy re-reading stories and this helps to build their confidence.






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
Floppy was dreaming about dragons.




Floppy saw a baby dragon with
its mother.




The mother dragon saw Floppy.
“Go away,” she roared.




The dragon roared again and flapped her wings.




She flew at Floppy.

out of the dragon's mouth again.




“Help!” said Floppy.


“The bridge is on fire.”




Floppy ran back across
the bridge.




He ran past a rock and saw the baby dragon again.




The mother dragon roared at Floppy. She flew up onto a high rock.


