She is a great vet.


She is so friendly and gentle.

But I am allergic to cats."






"Could it be?" I ask Gus on the way home.

"This is the best part of my job," the vet says.






In the fall, my scout troop

"and make sure they get good food.


Healthy cows make lots of good milk."

"So what kind of vet do you want to be?" Dr. Wells asks me. I think it over. Then—achoo!






The cat next to me makes me sneeze.


"I don't know," I say.






